



2012 General Campground Information

- **CHECK-IN/OUT TIMES:** All campgrounds have a check-in and checkout time of 11:00 AM. Any site occupied after 11:00am will be subject to an additional night's fee. Please move your vehicle/tent from the campground by 11:00am on your day of checkout.
- **CAMPSITE CAPACITY:** Individual campsites have an occupancy limit of eight (8) persons maximum, except for Wonder Lake Campground which has a maximum of four (4) persons.
- **CAMPSITE ASSIGNMENT:** Most of Denali National Park's campgrounds operate on a non-site assignment basis -generally. However, sites at Riley Creek and Savage River Campgrounds are reserved on a size-specific basis: "A" sites which can accommodate RV's up to 40' and "B" sites for smaller RV's less than 30'. Prices reflect site size and you must stay in the site type in which your reservation was made; all sites can accommodate tents. Savage River Campground has a designated loop with pull-through "A" sites specifically designed for RV's 31 feet and longer. This loop is located on the first left turn after entering the Savage River Campground service road.
- **TENTS:** A maximum of three (3) tents are allowed per campsite. Tents must be erected on raised tent pads when provided. At Teklanika Campground, tents may only be erected on the gravel parking pads in each camp site.
- **VEHICLES:** Vehicles must be parked within your designated campsite parking space. One (1) motor vehicle is permitted Teklanika Campgrounds; no towed vehicles permitted (unless essential to the camping experience (i.e. tent trailers). Sanctuary, Igloo and Wonder Lake have bus access only. There is a 40 foot limit on RV length that can be accommodated within all park RV-accessible campgrounds.
- **GENERATOR HOURS:** Generators may be operated in the Riley Creek, Savage River, and Teklanika River Campgrounds between 8:00am – 10:00am and 4:00pm – 8:00pm only. Operation of a generator or idling of a parked vehicle for the purpose of electricity generation outside of these hours is prohibited; no exceptions. If your stay requires the use of a generator beyond the designated hours, there are several campgrounds in the surrounding area that may better suit your needs
- **QUIET HOURS:** 10pm to 6am
- **FOOD STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Food, drinks, coolers, and cooking utensils (including stoves and grills) and all scented items must be secured in a hard-sided vehicle or designated food locker when not immediately in use. Never leave food unattended, even for a short time. All garbage must be properly disposed of immediately in campground provided bear proof garbage cans.
- **FIRES:** Fires are permitted at Riley Creek, Savage and Teklanika Campgrounds in established campsite fire grates only. No fires are permitted at Sanctuary, Igloo or Wonder Lake. Firewood is available for sale at the Riley Creek Mercantile at Mile 0.5 on the Park Road; dead and down wood may be collected within a short walking distance of your registered campground, but not within sight of the road. Do not burn trash. Do not leave a fire unattended.
- **PETS:** Pets must remain on a leash and can be walked on roadways only (no trails, or off the road). Do not leave pets unattended at any time. Pet food is to be stored and handled in the same manner as human food, and stored in a hard sided vehicle or food locker when not in use. Pet waste must be picked up and disposed of in a garbage can.



- **WILDLIFE:** Never feed wildlife of any kind (this includes gulls, squirrels, and foxes). Respect wildlife viewing distances. Report bears in or near the campground to the campground host or a ranger immediately. Do not leave infants or small children unattended - wolves and bears may be more curious and less intimidated by children.
- Dispose of gray water at the following locations:
 - **Riley Creek Campground:** use gray water sinks near the restrooms; clean food particles out of and rinse sinks, dispose of food particles in bear proof trash cans, and close doors when you leave.
 - **Savage Campground:** dump gray water in the flush toilets, not in portable toilets.
 - **Teklanika Campground:** use gray water basins near the restrooms; please clean food particles out of basin and rinse with water from a spigot.
 - **Sanctuary Campground:** remove food particles from gray water and dispose of in bear proof trash cans; disperse cleaned gray water in bushes away from campsites.
 - **Wonder Lake Campground:** use gray water sink at the restroom building; clean food particles out of and rinse the sink well.

WARNING

The following items (new, clean, dirty, empty or full) should **NOT** be left outside or in tent trailers at any time, **DAY OR NIGHT**, unless they are in immediate use! Store items in hard sided vehicles (RV or auto) or in the food storage lockers provided in each campground.

TEKLANIKA CAMPGROUND INFORMATION

Please note the following specific regulations regarding this campground.

- Campground speed limit is 10 mph.
- Park Road travel with a valid Teklanika campground permit is limited to one round trip allowing the vehicle to travel as far as Teklanika Campground and return to the Park entrance. **No additional travel by private vehicle will be permitted.** Further Park travel will be through the Teklanika Pass. This should be purchased in addition to your campground permit when making your reservation.
- If you are driving an RV to Teklanika Campground, dump holding tanks and fill up with fresh water **BEFORE** going to Teklanika. There is a dump station located adjacent to the Riley Creek Mercantile. There are no dumping/filling stations at the Teklanika Campground.
